
As you may be aware that the Hon'ble Supreme Court in its order has completely banned Ragging and the U.G.C., on the directives of the Supreme Court framed guidelines with regard to combating the menace of ragging in the Universities/ Educational Institutions, according to which ragging besides being a reprehensible act, is now a punishable offence.

The University in pursuance of the order of Hon'ble Supreme Court and the Guidelines of the UGC considers vide No. F/1-15/2009/(Anti-Ragging) dated 23.6.2011 "Ragging in any form" is an act of indiscipline and misconduct and the students indulging in such act shall be punished as per rules prescribed in the AMU Students' Conduct & Discipline Rules, 1985, which may include suspension or even expulsion of the student from the rolls of the University.

As the University after vacation has already been opened from 1.8.2011, it is requested to kindly make the students aware of this fact very well by displaying notices at the appropriate places and take preventive measures by forming "Anti-Ragging Committees" with the involvement of teachers and some senior students. The members of the Committee may remain extra vigilant to keep watch on the students in their respective areas.
