Applications on prescribed form are invited for the appointment against the **one (01) Guest Teacher** in the **DEPARTMENT OF PHILOSOPHY, Faculty of Arts**. The emoluments of Guest teacher will be as per guidelines in UGC letter No. F-0-1/2009 (PS) dated 06 February 2010 and clarification issued by MHRD vide their letter No. F-39-2/2013(DC) dated 27 May, 2014 i.e. **Rs.1, 000 per lecture** subject to a maximum of Rs. 25,000/- per month for the Session 2018-19. The appointment will be made on purely temporary basis liable to terminate at any time without notice or assignment of reason.

**ESSENTIAL QUALIFICATIONS:**

- i) Good academic record as defined by the University with at least 55% marks (or on an equivalent grade B in the 7 point scale wherever grading system is followed) at the **Master's Degree level in Philosophy** from an Indian University, or an equivalent degree from an accredited Indian or foreign University.
- ii) Besides fulfilling the above qualifications, the candidate must have cleared the National Eligibility Test (NET) conducted by the UGC, CSIR or similar test(s) accredited by the UGC.
- iii) Notwithstanding anything contained in clauses (i) and (ii), candidates who have been awarded PhD degree in accordance with the University Grants Commission (Minimum Standards and Procedure for Award of PhD degree) Regulations 2009, shall be exempted from NET.
- iv) Further the award of degrees to candidates registered for the MPhil/PhD programme prior to July 11, 2009, shall be governed by the provisions of the then existing Ordinances/By laws/Regulations of the Institution awarding the degrees and the PhD candidates shall be exempted from the requirement of the minimum eligibility condition of NET subject to the fulfillment of the following conditions:
  - a) PhD degree of the candidate awarded in regular mode
  - b) Evaluation of the PhD thesis by at least two external examiners
  - c) Candidates had published two research papers out of which at least one is in refereed journal from out her/his PhD work
  - d) The candidate had presented two papers in seminars/conferences from out her/his PhD work
  - e) Open PhD Viva-Voce of the candidate has been conducted

(a) to (e) as above are to be certified by the Vice-Chancellor/Pro Vice-Chancellor/ Dean (Academic Affairs)/ Dean (University Instructions)

**NOTE:**

- (i) A relaxation of 5% may be provided at the Masters/Graduate level for the SC/ST, Persons with Disabilities (PwDs).
- (ii) A relaxation of 5% may be provided in the marks, of PhD Degree holder, who obtained their Master's degree prior to 19 September 1991.
- (iii) B in the 7 point scale with letter grade O, A, B, C, D, E and F shall be regarded as equivalent to 55% wherever the grading system is followed.
- (iv) A relaxation of 50% marks at the PG level may be provided to candidates who have cleared JRF conducted by UGC/CSIR prior to 1989, when the minimum marks required to appear for JRF Examination was 50%.
