Applications on the prescribed form are invited for the appointment of **Guest Teacher in Sanskrit** (One post) in the Women's College, AMU, Aligarh on payment of an honorarium as per University rules. The appointment will be on purely temporary basis till the end of the Academic Session 2016-17 and liable to termination at any time without any notice or assignment of reason:

Essential Qualifications:

- i) Good academic record as defined by the concerned university with at least 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed) at the Master's Degree level in the relevant subject from an Indian University or an equivalent degree from an accredited foreign university;
- ii) Besides fulfilling the above qualifications, the candidate must have cleared the National Eligibility Test (NET) Conducted by the UGC, CSIR or similar test accredited by the UGC like SLET/SET;
- iii) Notwithstanding anything contained in sub-clauses (i) and (ii) above, candidates, who are or have been awarded a Ph.D. Degree in accordance with the UGC (Minimum Standards and Procedure for Award of Ph.D. Degree) Regulations, 2009 shall be exempted from the requirement of the minimum eligibility condition of NET/SLET/SET for recruitment and appointment of Assistant Professor or equivalent positions in Universities/Colleges/Institutions;


Further, the award of degrees to candidates registered for the M.Phil / Ph.D. programme prior to July 11, 2009, shall be governed by the provisions of the then existing Ordinances/ By Laws /Regulations of the Institution awarding the degrees and the Ph.D. candidates shall be exempted from the requirement of the minimum eligibility condition of "NET/SET/SET for requirement and appointment of Assistant Professor of equivalent positions in Universities/ Colleges/Institutions subject to the fulfillment of the conditions:

- (a) Ph.D. degree of the candidate awarded in regular mode only.
 - (b) Evaluation of the Ph.D. thesis by at least two external examiners.
 - (c) Candidates had published two research papers out of which at least one in a refereed journal from out of which at least one in a refereed journal from out of his/ her Ph.D. work.
 - (d) The candidate had presented two papers in seminars/ conferences from out his/ her Ph.D. work.
 - (e) Open Ph.D. Viva-Voce of the candidate had been conducted.
- (a) To (e) as above are to be certified by the Vice Chancellor/ Pro- Vice Chancellor/Dean (Academic Affairs/Dean (University Instructions).
- iv) NET/SLET/SET shall also not be required for such Master Programms in disciplines for which NET/SLET/SET is not conducted.

Note:

1. A relaxation of 5% may be provided from 55% to 50% of the marks at the Graduate / Master's level for the SC /ST/Physically and visually handicapped candidates.
2. A relaxation of 5% may be provided from 55% to 50% of the marks to the Ph.D. Degree holders, who have passed their Master's Degree prior to 19th September, 1991.
3. Relevant grade which is regarded as equivalent of 55% where the grading system is followed by recognized University shall also be considered eligible.
